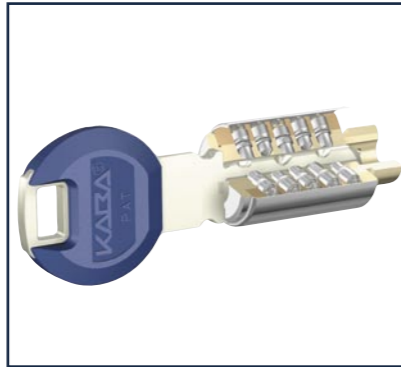


Security Revolving Doors

Versions of Geryon can be used internally or externally in weather-proof facades, as standard. A choice of glass or metal body, extended passage heights, glass roofs and various security control devices including biometric verification makes this a popular and versatile range.

External versions can have waterproof canopies, drainage in the outer door segment and curved sliding night wings to shut the unit off at night-time -especially useful in busy city centres. Internally, all glass versions provide access control without a negative effect on the reception environment.

The door rotates and blocks automatically. Attempts to force the door are met by a passive response (high resistance value) and an active response (reversing at low force). No-one is either placed in danger or locked in. The interrupted passage is then completed or the rest position located. If no one passes through the revolving door, after a settable time the door will time out and remain locked.



Access Control

Kaba's access control product range has developed from mechanical access control products, including the quality and security of the familiar dimpled key and the patented Kaba 20 brand, with its 22mm round profile mechanical locking system, to now include electronic access control with biometric access control devices and integrated mechatronic access control products.

The Kaba dimpled key is available within two product ranges, the original Kaba 20, which is widely used for both commercial and industrial applications and the recently developed Kaba experT system, which allows Kaba partners to assemble cylinders whilst maintaining the high level of security established by Kaba.

The Kaba Gege range of cylinders includes the patented CNS Stop Key which has the qualities you would expect from a cylinder that meets CEN Grade 5.

Security Solutions for Retail



Kaba's security products are used extensively in the retail sector, most well known are Kaba's range of push button locks and safelocks. These two products reflect the diversity of our portfolio but represent only a part of the range that Kaba manufacturers that are integrated to form a complete solution ranging from staff management to protecting cash rooms.

Unlike many environments the retail industry usually operates two distinct areas in most outlets, the shop floor and the back of house where the stores and cash handling are located. Apart from restricting access to members of the public to the secure areas, the retail industry is often required to manage the access and movement of employees, whether they are temporary or permanent.

By creating zones that have increase levels of security it is possible to restrict access and to minimise loss of stock or money via theft.



Kaba has worked in partnership with many leading retail organisations, whether they are the end user or contractor to create solutions using either standard or bespoke products that can be used in the high street, shopping centres and individual retail outlets that may handle very high value items.

External Security




Retail outlets are the most likely to be attacked and often repeatedly due to the high value of the stock and the relative ease in which stolen goods can be distributed. Kaba has designed and manufactured a range of high security cylinders that can withstand repeated attacks and due to the profile, they are impossible to duplicate. When combined with the flexibility of electronic access control, the Kaba elolegic product range creates the perfect solution. The Kaba elolegic cylinder uses a mechanical key with a Legic proximity chip to give you control and security. The locking of a door is only part of the solution, Kaba security doors complete the package to resist unauthorised access.

Staff Management




If your employees enter the retail unit from an external door there is a need to prevent unauthorised access, yet still allow employees to enter as they need to. By issuing employees with a Legic proximity smartcard and implementing the Kaba exos access control system, your colleagues will be able to enter the unit when they need to and it will prevent any unauthorised access. The online system will allow for the immediate adding and removal of access rights, an audit train of all personnel entering and will give an immediate alarm if the door is forced open or held open for too long! The same Legic card can also be used with a Kaba time and attendance system, which when integrated into a payroll system can reduce the cost of calculating pay and reduces payroll error.

Shop Floor to Stores Access




Most retail unit restrict access from the retail shop floor to the back of house area. Kaba has been a leader in this situation with its range of push button locks. The code can be changed quickly without removal from the door and it can be shared amongst employees. If the code needs to be changed, it can be done quickly and without expertise. Whilst offering a lower level of security this is a situation that requires restricted access with control rather than high security solutions.

Cash Office & High Value Goods Stores



The areas with high value of goods and that hold money are the zones that need the highest level of security internally and often need an audit trail to establish who entered the area and at what time. The situation can vary from a cash office to cabinets in a jewellers, where every item is of a very high value, yet the needs are the same. In this environment Kaba would again utilise the Kaba elolegic product range, stand alone, high security, flexibility to give and remove access rights and of course the ability to provide an extensive audit trail should it be needed.
